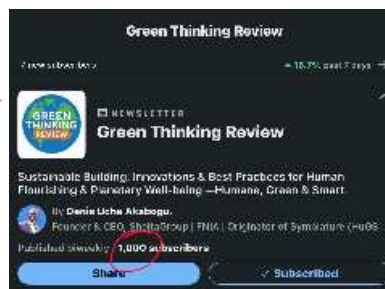
Today, we celebrate an important milestone.
